For use only by a dental professional in the recommended indications.

**RECOMMENDED INDICATIONS**

- A. GRADIA DIRECT ANTERIOR
  - 1. Direct restorative for Class III, IV, V cavities.
  - 2. Direct restorative for class V defects and root surface cavities.
  - 3. Direct restorative for veneers and diastema closure.
- B. GRADIA DIRECT POSTERIOR (radiopaque)
  - 1. Direct restorative for Class I and II cavities

**CONTRAINdications**

- 1. Pulp capping.
- 2. In rare cases the product may cause sensitivity in some people. If any such reactions are experienced, discontinue the use of the product and refer to a physician.

**DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

Clean the tooth with pumice and water. Shade selection should be made prior to isolation. Select the appropriate GRADIA DIRECT shades by referring to the GRADIA DIRECT shade guide.

## 2. Cavity Preparation

Prepare cavity using standard techniques.

Note : For pulp capping, use calcium hydroxide.

For bonding GRADIA DIRECT to enamel and / or dentin, use a light-cured bonding system such as GC Fuji BOND™, GC UniPIL™ Bond or GC G-BOND™ (Fig. 1). Follow manufacturer's instructions.

## 4. Placement of GRADIA DIRECT

## 1) Dispensing from a Unilip

Insert the GRADIA DIRECT Unit into the UniPIL APPLIER or equivalent. Remove the cap and extrude material directly into the prepared cavity. Use steady pressure (Fig. 2). Maintain pressure on the applicator handle while removing the UniPIL APPLIER and Unit from the mouth. This will ensure that no material comes loose from the applicator.

2) Dispensing from a syringe

Remove syringe cap and dispense material onto a mixing pad. Place the material into the cavity using a suitable placement instrument.

After dispensing, screw syringe plunger anticlockwise by a half to full turn to release residual pressure inside the syringe. Replace cap immediately after use.

Note :

1. Basically, material can be applied in a single layer to achieve aesthetic restorations using Standard shades. For details, refer to the Clinical Hints.

2. Material tends to harden to extrude immediately after removing from cold storage. Prior to use, leave to stand for a few minutes at room normal temperature.

3. After dispensing, avoid too long an exposure to ambient light. Ambient light can shorten the manipulation time.

**Clinical Hints**

## 1. Anterior cavities

In the case of small cavities Restore using a one shade layering technique. In most cases the use of one Standard shade alone will be sufficient. In cases where a higher degree of translucency is needed, one of the Outside special shades can be selected. See also Examples of Clinical Applications.

In most cases a multi shade layering technique will give the best aesthetic results. To block out shine throughs from the oral cavity or to mask discolored dentin, select an appropriate Inside special shade and continue to build up with a Standard shade.


To make a restoration more life like e.g. to copy anatomical changes in the gingiva, first lay a thin layer of an Outside special shade. See also Examples of Clinical Applications and / or consult the Shade Combination Chart.

## 2. Posterior cavities

Restore using a one shade layering technique. In most cases the use of one Standard shade alone will be sufficient. In cases where a higher translucency is needed, one of the Outside special shades can be selected. See also Examples of Clinical Applications.

In the case of deep cavities Place a flowable composite such as GRADIA DIRECT Flo or GRADIA DIRECT Flo or GRADIA DIRECT using a Standard shade. For optimal aesthetics use an Outside special shade as the final composite layer. See also Examples of clinical applications.

"GC Fuji LINING® PASTE PAK, GC Fuji LINING® LC or GC Fuji IX GP can be used as a liner or base material. Follow the respective manufacturer's instructions for use."

**AANBEVELLEN TOEPASSINGEN**

- 1. Directe restauraties in I en II<sup>o</sup> V-cavities.
- 2. Directe restauraties in wigmoezel defecten en bij wortelcarries.
- 3. Directe restauraties voor veneers in de stam van diastema.

**GRADIA DIRECT POSTERIOR (radigopake)**

- 1. Directe restauraties in Klasse I en II cavities.

**CONTRA-INDICATIES**

- 1. Pulpovaakapping.
- 2. In enkele zeldzame gevallen kan het product bij bepaalde personen overgevoeligheid veroorzaaken. Indien dergelijke reacties optreden, gebruik een andere composit en niet langer een radigopake arts.

**GEbruIKSAANWIJZING**

- 1. Kleurensel:

Reinig het element met puimsteen en water. Maak een kleurensel alvorens het materiaal te isoleren. Selecteer de juiste GRADIA DIRECT kleuren met behulp van de GRADIA DIRECT kleurengids.

2. Cavitiespreparatie:

Gebruik calciumhydroxide voor pulpa-ovakapping.

3. Aanbrengen van een bonding:

Om GRADIA DIRECT aan te brengen moet u eerst de bondingssysteem zoals GC Fuji BOND LC, GC UniFil® Bond of GC G-BOND™ (Fig. 1).



Volg de instructies van de fabrikant.

4. Het aanbrengen van GRADIA DIRECT

Breed de GRADIA DIRECT Unit in een Unip pistol of in een gelijksoortig instrument.

Verwijder het dopje en spuit het materiaal met gelijkmatige druk direct in de gerepareerde cavity (Fig. 2). Houd lichte druk op het handvat om de cavity te stabiliseren en duw de mondventiel. Dil voorkomt dat de Unip uit het pistol valt.

2) Appliceren van een sprutje:

Verwijder het dopje van het sprutje en spuit materiaal op een model of een ander voorwerp in de cavity met een daarnaar geschikt instrument.

Na het extruderen de plunjier van het sprutje een hele slag tegen de klok in treuren daarna om navloeien van het materiaal te voorkomen. Herplaats het dopje direct na gebruik.

Opmerking :

1. Normala, kan voor het verkrijgen van een esthetische restauratie in een enkele laag met gebruik van Standard kleuren worden aangebracht. Radigopake de klinische adviezen voor meer details.

2. Extruderen van het materiaal kan lastig zijn, indien het koel werd bewaard. Laat het materiaal een aantal minuten op kamertemperatuur komen, alvorens het te verwarmen.

3. Voorkom dat geaarderde materiaal te lang aan licht wordt blootgesteld. Lekken kan de verwerkingslijst aanzienlijk verkorten.

Klinische adviezen ]

1. Antieke cavities:

a. In het geval van kleine cavities:

Restaurer door middel van de laagstegevele ovaakappachet met een enkele kleur, die de meeste kleuren heeft. In die gevallen waarbij een hogere graad van transculente is gewenst, kan voor één van de "Outside special" kleuren worden gekozen. Zie ook de voorbeelden van klinische applicaties.

b. In geval van grote cavities:

In de meeste gevallen zal een meerdere laagstegevele de beste ovaaktechniek zijn. Om het droogheen van een enkele kleur in de meesten gevallen zal het gebruik van een enkele kleur. In die gevallen waarbij een hogere graad van transculente is gewenst, kan voor één van de "Outside special" kleuren worden gekozen. Zie ook de voorbeelden van klinische applicaties.

c. In het geval van diepe cavities:

Breng een "flowable" composiet zoals GRADIA DIRECT Flo of GRADIA DIRECT LoFlo™ aan op de bodem van de cavity. Breng daarna een Standard kleur aan. Gebruik voor de afwerklaag een "Outside special" kleur omdat dit een optimale esthetiek te verkrijgen.

- 3. Bonding: Treatment: Bond for both GRADIA DIRECT in enamel and/or dentin, using a light-cured bonding system such as GC Fuji Bond, GC Fuji Bond II, GC Fuji Bond GP (Fig. 1). Follow manufacturer's instructions.

- 4. Placement of GRADIA DIRECT: Untip the GRADIA DIRECT Untip into the preparation cavity. Remove the cap and extrude material directly into the prepared cavity. Use steady pressure (Fig. 2).

- 5. Maintenance: Maintain pressure on the applier handle while removing the Untip after dispensing the material from the tip.

- 6. Dispensing from a syringe: Remove the dispensing material onto a mixing pad. Place the material into the cavity using a suitable placement instrument.

- 7. After dispensing, screw syringe plunger anticlockwise by half to full turn to remove pressure inside the syringe. This prevents the Untip from coming loose from the applier.
